A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second and final) of professional service contracts between certain providers and the County's Department of Job and Family Services and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments, to provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program, for the period 7/1/20 to 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,307,357.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ohio recently consolidated the delivery of Workforce Investment Opportunity Act ("WIOA") and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") funded youth services under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program ("CCMEP"); and

WHEREAS, Ohio requires its Local Workforce Areas to work collaboratively with County Departments of Job and Family Services to administer CCMEP services; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") seeks to jointly renew agreements with Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA COG") and four providers for CCMEP youth workforce development services; and

WHEREAS, CCMEP provides employment and training services to low-income, inschool and out-of-school, youth aged 14 to 24, based on a comprehensive assessment of employment and training needs, as well as a basic skills assessment; and

WHEREAS, CCMEP participants are provided services to support goals outlined in their Individual Opportunity Plan ("IOP"), which may include objectives, such as, obtaining a high school diploma, job placement, work experience and other identified supportive services, such as, childcare and transportation; and

WHEREAS, CCMEP services are provided with the goals of assisting at-risk youth in achieving major educational goals, skill development and/or employment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 27, 2020, awarded a renewal (second and final) of a professional service contracts between certain providers and DJFS and the SAMWAS COG to provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the CCMEP for the period 7/1/20 to 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,307,357.00, as more fully set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, as required by the CCMEP, said professional service contracts will be funded by both WIOA funding through the SAMWA COG and TANF funding through DJFS; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to enter into the aforementioned professional service contracts;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The award by the Board of Control a renewal (second and final) of professional service contracts between certain providers and the County's Department of Job and Family Services and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments to provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program, for the period 7/1/20 to 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,307,357.00, as more fully set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said contracts and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services effective 7/1/20.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
