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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a bomb disposal**
8 **robot for the Youngstown Bomb Squad for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$75,000.00,**
9 **for the County Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public**
10 **Safety, Emergency Management Agency and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a bomb disposal robot
16 for the Youngstown Bomb Squad for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$75,000.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, said equipment will be fully grant-funded; and

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20 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

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23 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
24 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County
25 Executive to advertise for bids for a bomb disposal robot for the Youngstown Bomb Squad.

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that;

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for a bomb disposal robot for
33 the Youngstown Bomb Squad for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$75,000.00.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
38 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the County
39 Executive to immediately advertise for bids in order to procure the necessary equipment within
40 the grant performance period.

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall
46 take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
