SECTION 1

This Council finds and determines that the upgrade and expansion of jail management and virtual courtroom systems due to the public health emergency is an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit.

SECTION 2

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for consulting and project management services for jail management and virtual courtroom systems, due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, in an amount not to exceed \$145,189.40, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 3

This Council finds and declares that the expenditure of funds for the professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc. is necessary due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic, and is being done in compliance with the provisions of section 5001 of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act.

SECTION 4

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes a necessary professional service contract that will afford all Courts within Summit County and the Sheriff the ability to safely and efficiently work remotely and improve their operations due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic while continuing to ensure that the inmates' constitutional rights are protected.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
