WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO 1229 (Medical Examiner's Unit) and the County Executive, for the period 4/1/20 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in pay; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement and any necessary related documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Medical Examiner's Unit) and the County Executive, for the period 4/1/20 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a two and one-half percent (2.5%) increase in pay and any necessary related documents

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing a timely collective bargaining agreement Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Medical Examiner's), and the County Executive.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the County Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
