7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into five Local Public Agency agreements**
8 **with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, located in Council**
9 **Districts 1, 4, and 5, for resurfacing projects on Ravenna Road, Valley View Road, Akron-**
10 **Cleveland Road, Olde 8 Road, and Smith Road, for an estimated total projects' cost not to**
11 **exceed \$4,050,000.00, with the Department of Transportation providing Federal Surface**
12 **Transportation Block Grant funds of up to \$3,100,000.00 to cover up to 80% of the**
13 **projects' construction costs, with the Engineer being responsible for the balance of the**
14 **projects' costs, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the Engineer's Office proposes improving: (1) Ravenna Road from north of
17 Old Mill Road to the City of Twinsburg corporate line (Project Identification Number 108140);
18 (2) Valley View Road from Olde 8 Road to State Route 8 (Project Identification Number
19 108141); (3) Akron-Cleveland Road from the City of Cuyahoga Falls corporate line to the
20 Village of Boston Heights corporate line (Project Identification Number 108453); (4) Olde 8
21 Road from the Village of Boston Heights corporate line to East Highland Road (Project
22 Identification Number 108454); and (5) Smith Road from the City of Fairlawn corporate line to
23 Sand Run Road (Project Identification Number 108865), with said improvements including
24 roadway repairs and resurfacing and adding four foot wide shoulders to the roadways where
25 possible, (hereinafter referred to as the "Projects") in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5; and

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27 WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the five resurfacing Projects is \$4,050,000.00; and

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29 WHEREAS, Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, programmed through the Akron
30 Metropolitan Area Transportation Study, have been awarded to the Engineer's office for grants
31 to cover up to 80% of the Projects' construction costs, in an amount not to exceed \$3,100,000.00,
32 with the Engineer's Office being responsible to provide the remaining funds necessary for the
33 Projects' costs; and

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35 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Transportation
36 ("ODOT"), and the Engineer desire to enter into Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreements, with
37 a copy of each LPA agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, to
38 confirm the Projects' costs and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for
39 administration of the Projects; and

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41 WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03(c) and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, as well as
42 Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter allow execution of such LPA
43 agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

45 WHEREAS, said LPA Agreement will provide (i) the estimated cost of the Projects (ii)
46 that ODOT shall provide to the County as the LPA up to 80% of eligible Project costs, using
47 Surface Transportation Block Grant funds and (iii) that the County, as the LPA, will provide the
48 remaining funds necessary from Motor Vehicle Gas Tax funds, to pay for the Projects' costs; and

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50 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, by reviewing all pertinent information, that it
51 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
52 execute the aforementioned LPA agreements with ODOT;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute Local Public Agency (“LPA”) agreements
10 with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation (“ODOT”), for the: (1)
11 Ravenna Road Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108140); (2) Valley View
12 Road Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108141); (3) Akron-Cleveland Road
13 Resurfacing Project (Project Identification Number 108453); (4) Olde 8 Road Resurfacing
14 Project (Project Identification Number 108454), and (5) Smith Road Resurfacing Project (Project
15 Identification Number 108865) (the “Projects”) located in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, with a
16 copy of each LPA agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with
17 such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said LPA
18 agreements and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively
19 evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive. Upon federal
20 authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Projects,
21 including the advertisement for bids for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$4,050,000.00, with
22 the award of the Projects subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,
23 said Ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control and/or County
24 Council.

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26 SECTION 2

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28 The LPA agreements will show the Projects’ descriptions and costs are broken down as
29 follows:

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
36 completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
