7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute intergovernmental agreements with**  
8 **eleven local law enforcement agencies to provide diversion services to unruly and**  
9 **misdemeanant youth within their respective jurisdictions without an official referral to the**  
10 **Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, in a total**  
11 **amount not to exceed \$206,575.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and**  
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Youth Services has awarded the Court of Common  
15 Pleas-Juvenile Division a Delinquent Care and Custody Grant to fund diversion services to  
16 unruly and misdemeanant youth without an official referral to the Court of Common Pleas-  
17 Juvenile Division, for the period 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed  
18 \$206,575.00; and

20 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division desires to enter into  
21 intergovernmental agreements with eleven local law enforcement agencies as set forth in Exhibit  
22 A, to provide said diversion services to unruly and misdemeanant youth within their respective  
23 jurisdictions; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
27 execute the aforementioned intergovernmental agreements and any other necessary documents;

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29 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
30 of Ohio, that:

32 SECTION 1

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34 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute intergovernmental agreements and any  
35 other necessary documents with eleven local law enforcement agencies to provide diversion  
36 services to unruly and misdemeanant youth within their respective jurisdictions without an  
37 official referral to the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, for the period 7/1/20 through  
38 6/30/21, in a total amount not to exceed \$206,575.00, as set forth in Exhibit A.

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40 SECTION 2

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42 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
43 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
44 provide diversion services to unruly and misdemeanant youth effective 7/1/20.

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46 SECTION 3

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48 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
49 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
50 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


