	WHEREAS, triage/stability team services will include around the clock in-field crisis intervention, safety planning and, when applicable, emergency shelter in suites dedicated to APS seniors at the BWS facility and in addition, the triage/stability team will conduct timely welfare checks for vulnerable seniors whose cases have been completed to prevent recurring abuse, neglect or exploitation; and
