A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8, Local 3885 (Child Support Enforcement Agency) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Prosecutor's Office), and the Executive and the Prosecutor, for a one-year term, from 10/1/20 through 9/30/2021, which authorizes a two and one half percent (2.5%) increase in pay, for the Executive and the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the Executive, Ohio Council 8, Local 3885 (Child Support Enforcement Agency) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Prosecutor's Office), for a one-year term, from 10/1/2020 through 9/30/2021, which authorizes a two and one half percent (2.5%) increase in pay; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8, Local 3885 (Child Support Enforcement Agency) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (Prosecutor's Office) and the Executive and the Prosecutor, for a one-year term, from 10/1/2020 through 9/30/2021, which authorizes a two and one half percent (2.5%) increase in pay.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of providing a timely collective bargaining agreement between the Local 3885 (Child Support Enforcement Agency), the Executive and the Prosecutor.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
