This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for the purchase of body cameras to be used by Sheriff's Deputies pursuant to their policing duties in the Patrol Division, Court Services and for those Sheriff's Deputies who are assigned to rotary contracts in communities that have not already procured cameras to document the performance of their law enforcement duties.
