An amended Resolution authorizing the County Executive to apply for, and accept, funds from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund for the repair and replacement of home sewage treatment systems, in the amount of \$300,000.00, with no an estimated \$20,000 client provided local cash match requirement, authorizing the Executive to execute a Water Pollution Loan Control Loan Fund Assistance Agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for said purposes, and appropriating funds, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.
