7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a one-year policing contract with**  
8 **the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority, pursuant to which the County Sheriff will**  
9 **provide 3,757.16 deputy/sergeant hours, for the period 1/1/16 to 12/31/16, for the amount of**  
10 **\$245,210.66, for the Sheriff and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (“AMHA”), in the City of  
13 Akron, in Council District 1, has requested that that the County of Summit enter into a one-year  
14 policing contract pursuant to which the County Sheriff will provide 3,757.16 deputy/sergeant  
15 hours, for the period 1/1/16 to 12/31/16.; and

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17 WHEREAS, AMHA has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$245,210.66 during the  
18 one-year term of the contract; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information  
21 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
22 Executive to execute the aforementioned policing contract with AMHA;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
25 of Ohio, that;

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a one-year policing contract with  
30 the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (“AMHA”), in the City of Akron, in Council District  
31 1, pursuant to which the County Sheriff will provide AMHA with 3,757.16 deputy/sergeant  
32 hours, for the period of 1/1/16 to 12/31/16, in exchange for payment from AMHA in the amount  
33 of \$245,210.66 for the one-year term of the contract.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately  
39 providing necessary policing to AMHA effective 1/1/16.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
