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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Montrose Ford Inc. for four new vehicles, under CUE pricing, in a total amount not to**
9 **exceed \$81,710.18, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting on April 20, 2016, awarded a purchase
12 contract with Montrose Ford, Inc., for three unmarked 2017 Ford Fusion SE FWD vehicles and
13 one unmarked 2016 Ford F-150 4X4 pick-up truck, under CUE pricing, in a total amount not to
14 exceed \$81,710.18, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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16 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
17 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc., is necessary and in the best
18 interest of the County of Summit;

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20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
21 of Ohio, that:

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23 SECTION 1

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25 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Montrose Ford, Inc. for
26 three unmarked 2017 Ford Fusion SE FWD vehicles and one unmarked 2016 Ford F-150 4x4
27 pick-up truck, under CUE pricing, in a total amount not to exceed \$81,710.18, is hereby
28 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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30 SECTION 2

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32 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
33 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
34 replace unreliable vehicles for the Sheriff's Office in 2016.

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36 SECTION 3

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38 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
39 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
40 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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42 SECTION 4

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44 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
45 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
47 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
48 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
