7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental**
8 **agreement with the County of Summit Sheriff's Office for building security and fraud**
9 **investigation services, for the period 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$615,450.51, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 18, 2016, awarded an
14 intergovernmental agreement with the County of Summit Sheriff's Office, for building security
15 and fraud investigation services, for the period 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, in an amount not to
16 exceed \$615,450.51, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the
20 County of Summit;

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22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

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25 SECTION 1

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27 The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the County
28 of Summit Sheriff's Office, for building security and fraud investigation services, for the period
29 7/1/16 through 6/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$615,450.51, is hereby confirmed and the
30 County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such intergovernmental agreement.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 provide for building security and fraud investigation services effective 7/1/16.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
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


