A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation for the exchange of road salt, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2016-045, the County entered into a contract with Cargill, Inc. to purchase a specific amount of road salt to be used to treat county highways during the winter of 2015-2016; and

WHEREAS, due to an unusually mild winter, the County did not use the minimum agreed upon amount of road salt and the County is obligated to take delivery of more than 3,000 tons of salt; and

WHEREAS, the County and the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") have agreed that ODOT District 4 will take approximately 3,000 tons of salt into ODOT salt domes prior to September 1, 2016 in exchange for an equal amount of salt to be provided by ODOT into the County's salt domes prior to the end of the 2016-2017 snow season; and

WHEREAS, the County and ODOT wish to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for the exchange of road salt; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement with ODOT for the exchange of road salt;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

RESOLUTION NO.____

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The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation whereby the County will deliver approximately 3,000 tons of road salt to ODOT storage facilities located in Norton and Boston Heights prior to September 1, 2016 in exchange for an equal amount of salt to be provided by ODOT into the County's salt domes prior to the end of the 2016-2017 snow season. The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately allow the Executive to execute a necessary intergovernmental agreement to the exchange of road salt.
