7 **A Resolution increasing appropriations, in the amount of \$20,000.00, for the Victims of**  
8 **Crime Act grant, for the period of 10/1/15 through 9/30/16, for the Court of Common**  
9 **Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, this Council previously approved Resolution No. 2015-468, which  
12 authorized the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from  
13 the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2016 Victims of Crime Act  
14 (“VOCA”) grant, in the amount of \$97,542.40, with a local cash match requirement of  
15 \$24,385.60, for a total VOCA award total of \$121,928.00; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, the VOCA grant is to provide support salary and benefits for a victim  
18 advocate and a victim services coordinator, both full-time staff, providing advocacy services to  
19 crime victims in Summit County; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas- Juvenile Division has been awarded additional  
22 funding from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office totaling \$16,000.00, with a local cash  
23 match requirement of \$4,000.00, to purchase a copier for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile  
24 Division’s Court Appointed Special Advocate (“CASA”) department; and

26 WHEREAS, the local cash match requirement will be provided by the Court of Common  
27 Pleas-Juvenile Division’s General Fund budget; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,  
30 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to increase appropriations, in  
31 the amount of \$20,000.00, for the Court of Common Pleas- Juvenile Division’s Victims of Crime  
32 Act grant for the period of 10/1/15 through 9/30/16 for the aforementioned reasons;

19 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
20 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
