A Resolution declaring it necessary to submit the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy to the electors of the library district of the Akron-Summit County Public Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, for the purpose of current expenses of the Akron-Summit County Public Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council is the taxing authority of the County pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the Summit County Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Akron-Summit County Public Library (the "Library") is a library district and political subdivision of the State of Ohio organized under Section 3375.19 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Library Board of Trustees (the "Board") is a body politic and corporate organized under Section 3375.22; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Library has adopted a Resolution whereby it has declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Library, and it is necessary to levy a renewal of an existing tax in excess of such limitation for the current expenses of the Library; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid Resolution, the Board of the Library further requested that this Council, as the taxing authority for the Library, submit to the electors of the district of the Library, as established under Chapter 3375 of the Ohio Revised Code, at the primary election to be held May 4, 2021, the question of a renewal of an existing tax of 1.9 mills for the purpose of the current expenses of the Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, which tax shall be levied on the territory of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that the amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Library; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is necessary to levy a renewal of an existing tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the current expenses of the Library; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that such renewal tax constitutes a tax levy of 1.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to nineteen cents (\$0.19) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to be in effect for a period of six (6) years, to begin with the tax list and duplicate for the tax year 2021, the proceeds of which levy first would be available to the Library in the calendar year 2022, and collected through calendar year 2027, and such question should be submitted to the electors of the territory of the library district of the Library at the Primary Election to be held in Summit and Portage Counties on May 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to declare it necessary to submit the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy to the electors of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, for the purpose of current expenses of the Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby declares the necessity of submitting to the electors of the library district of the Akron-Summit County Public Library (the "Library") located in Summit and Portage Counties at the Primary Election to be held May 4, 2021, the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy for the purpose of current expenses of the Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, which tax shall be levied on the territory of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, outside the ten-mill limitation, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2

In accordance with Section 5705.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer for the calculation and certification of the total current tax valuation of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal of the existing 1.9 mill tax levy.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely certify to the Board of Elections of Summit and Portage Counties the issue of levying the aforementioned tax prior to the requisite deadline for the May 4, 2021 Primary Election.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
