A Resolution determining to proceed with submitting the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy to the electors of the library district of the Akron-Summit County Public Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, for the purpose of current expenses of the Akron-Summit County Public Library, for a period of six (6) years. commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council is the taxing authority of the County pursuant to Article III. Section 3.01 of the Summit County Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Library has adopted a Resolution whereby it has declared that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Library, and it is necessary to levy a renewal of an existing tax in excess of such limitation for the current expenses of the Library; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid Resolution, the Board of the Library further requested that this Council, as the taxing authority for the Library, submit to the electors of the district of the Library, as established under Chapter 3375 of the Ohio Revised Code, at the primary election to be held May 4, 2021, the question of a renewal of an existing tax of 1.9 mills for the purpose of the current expenses of the Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, which tax shall be levied on the territory of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties; and

WHEREAS, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-003 on January 4, 2021. declaring the necessity of submitting to the electors of the library district of the Akron and Summit County Public Library (the "Library") located in Summit and Portage Counties the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy for the purpose of current expenses of the Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, which tax shall be levied on the territory of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, outside the ten-mill limitation, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has advised and certified to the County Council the total current tax valuation of the territory of the library district of the Library and the revenue that will be generated by the renewal of the existing 1.9 mill tax levy in its first year of collection, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, having declared the necessity of submitting the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy to the electors of the library district of the Library, and the County Fiscal Officer having certified the necessary fiscal valuations, it is necessary for this Council to submit such renewal levy to the Board of Elections for Summit and Portage Counties for placement on the May 4, 2021 Primary Election ballot; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to proceed with submitting the question of a renewal of an existing 1.9 mill tax levy to the electors of the library district of the Akron-Summit County Public Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, for the purpose of current expenses of the Akron-Summit County Public Library, for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

This Council hereby acknowledges receipt from the Fiscal Officer of the certificate of the total current tax valuation of the territory of the library district of the Library and the revenue that will be generated by the renewal of the existing 1.9 mill tax levy in its first year of collection, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

### **SECTION 2**

This Council reaffirms the necessity of submitting this taxing measure to the electors and hereby determines to proceed with submitting to the electors of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties the question of a renewal of an existing tax of 1.9 mills for the purpose of current operating expenses of the Library for a period of six (6) years, commencing with tax year 2021, for collection in calendar years 2022 to 2027, which tax shall be levied on the territory of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, outside the ten-mill limitation, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code. Such renewal of an existing levy to constitute a tax levy of 1.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to nineteen cents (\$0.19) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to be in effect for a period of six (6) years, which tax shall be levied on the territory of the library district of the Library located in Summit and Portage Counties, beginning with the tax list and duplicate for tax year 2021, the proceeds of which levy first would be available to the Library in the calendar year 2022 and to be submitted to the electors of the library district of the Library at the Primary Election to be held in the County on May 4, 2021.

#### **SECTION 3**

In the event that the Ohio legislature, or any other proper authority, reschedules the May 4, 2021 Primary Election, the tax renewal levy shall be submitted to the electors on the rescheduled Primary Election date.

### **SECTION 4**

The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to certify to the Board of Elections of Summit and Portage Counties not later than 4:00 pm on February 2, 2021: (i) a copy of the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Library declaring the necessity of the 1.9 mill renewal levy; (ii) a copy of the Resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the 1.9 mill renewal levy; (iii) the certification by the Fiscal Officer as to the total current tax valuation of the

territory of the library district of the Library and the dollar amount of revenue to be generated by such levy; and (iv) a copy of this Resolution. This Council requests that the Board of Elections of Summit and Portage Counties give notice of the election and prepare the necessary ballots and supplies for the election in accordance with the law.

#### **SECTION 5**

The Directors of the Board of Elections of Summit and Portage Counties are hereby directed to cause notice of the election to be published once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks prior to the election in a newspaper of general circulation in each County, stating the purpose, the rate of the proposed tax levy, expressed in dollars and cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation as well as in mills for each one dollar of valuation, the number of years during which the levy shall be in effect, the first month and year in which the tax will be levied, and the time and place of the election. The Directors of the Board of Elections of Summit and Portage Counties are hereby directed to certify the result of the election, immediately after the canvas by the Board of Elections, to this Council, as the taxing authority of the Library, in order to permit the enactment of such levy, if approved by the electorate, for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the tax list and duplicate for tax year 2021, the proceeds of which levy first would be available to the Library in the calendar year 2022.
