WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a contract with Summa Health, as a Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project for the period 9/30/20 through 9/29/21 to continue to provide a Dual Diagnosis Support Group and other support groups for the Project; and
