7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**  
8 **professional service contract with Quality Control Inspection, Inc., for additional**  
9 **construction inspection task order services, in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.00 (for a**  
10 **cumulative increase of 62.2%), for a total amount not to exceed \$73,000.00, for the**  
11 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Engineer utilizes private construction inspectors when the Engineer'  
14 four full-time construction inspectors cannot meet all the inspection needs of ongoing projects;  
15 and

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17 WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously adopted Directive No. 002-20, which  
18 awarded a renewal (second and final) of a professional service contract with Quality Control  
19 Inspection, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for construction inspection task order services, for a  
20 one-year term, from 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, due to some unforeseen project delays causing multiple projects to occur at  
23 one time later in the year, additional inspectors are needed; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on January 13, 2021, awarded  
26 Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with Quality Control Inspection, Inc., for  
27 additional construction inspection task order services, in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.00  
28 (for a cumulative increase of 62.2%), for a total amount not to exceed \$73,000.00, subject to  
29 confirmation by this Council; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
32 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to professional service contract with Quality  
33 Control Inspection, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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35 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
36 of Ohio, that:

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40 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service  
41 contract with Quality Control Inspection, Inc., for additional construction inspection task order  
42 services, in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 62.2%), for a total  
43 amount not to exceed \$73,000.00, is hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to  
44 execute said change order and any other necessary related documents.

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48 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
49 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
50 provide for necessary additional construction inspection task order services.




