A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for project management for the development of a regional 9-1-1 dispatch center, in an amount not to exceed \$285,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk Management-Division of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Executive and Sheriff and the communities of Cuyahoga Falls, Fairlawn, Stow and Tallmadge are creating a regional 9-1-1 dispatch center; and

WHEREAS, MCM Consulting Group, Inc. has previously provided a needs assessment and strategic planning for the regional 9-1-1 dispatch center and consulting services to assist with acquisition of a new consolidated computer-aided dispatch ("CAD") system; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution 2017-444, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., to provide services in association with the consolidation of 9-1-1 dispatch systems and operations; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution 2017-445, which authorized the Executive to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the cities of Akron, Cuyahoga Falls, Fairlawn, Green and Stow, to share the cost of a professional service contact with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., to provide services in association with the consolidation of 9-1-1 dispatch services and operations; and

WHEREAS, MCM Consulting Group, Inc. is currently the project manager for the purchase and implementation of the new jail case management system and virtual courtroom system; and

WHEREAS, the Executive and Sheriff and the aforementioned communities seek to enter into a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, to continue to provide planning, engineering and project management services for the aforementioned regional 9-1-1 dispatch center, in an amount not to exceed \$285,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 3, 2021, awarded the aforementioned professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Executive intends to issue general obligation bonds to finance and/or reimburse costs for this Project, with the repayment of said bonds funded through agreements with participating communities and potentially a council of governments, representing many of these communities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for project management for the development of a regional 9-1-1 dispatch center, in an amount not to exceed \$285,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"). This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the consultation work along with the costs for designing, acquiring, constructing, equipping and any other expenses related to the Combined 911 Dispatch Center will be reimbursed with the proceeds of the bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this Section 2 is not to exceed \$10,000,000.00.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide project management for the development of a regional 9-1-1 dispatch center.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
