7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the purchase of a**
8 **Portable Gas Chromatograph Mass Spectrometer combination device for use by the**
9 **Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team, for an estimated total cost not to exceed**
10 **\$153,800.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management -**
11 **Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
14 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the purchase of a
17 Portable Gas Chromatograph Mass Spectrometer combination device ("GC/MS") for use by the
18 Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
19 \$153,800.00; and

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21 WHEREAS, the GC/MS will be purchased using Fiscal Year 2013 State Homeland
22 Security Grant Program funds; and

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24 WHEREAS, a copy of the specifications are attached as Exhibit A; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
28 advertise for bids for a GC/MS for the Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that;

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The County Executive to advertise for bids for the purchase of a Portable Gas
36 Chromatograph Mass Spectrometer combination device ("GC/MS") for use by the Hazardous
37 Materials Emergency Response Team, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$153,800.00.

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41 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
42 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
43 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for a GC/MS, a necessary piece of equipment for the
44 Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team.
