7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award from the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services of a**
9 **Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families grant to the County of**
10 **Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, for its Family Resource Center, for**
11 **the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the amount of \$370,000.00, with no local cash match**
12 **requirement, and appropriating grant funds, for the County of Summit Court of Common**
13 **Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services has
16 awarded a Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") grant to
17 the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division for its Family Resource
18 Center, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the amount of \$370,000.00, with no local cash
19 match requirement; and

21 WHEREAS, the Family Resource Center, which was established in 2006 through a grant
22 from DJFS, provides case management to at risk youth and their families who are involved in
23 domestic violence disputes, are pregnant or parenting teens, are teens at risk of dropping out of
24 school or are returning from long term stays at the Ohio Department of Youth Services, detention
25 or other placements; and

27 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the TANF grant funds; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
30 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
31 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned Federal Fiscal Year
32 2015 TANF grant from DJFS and to appropriate said grant funds;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

43 Resource Center, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the amount of \$370,000.00, with no
