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7 **A Resolution appropriating Community Development Block Grant funds, in the amount of**
8 **\$30,617.85, from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the purpose**
9 **of minor home repair projects for income-qualified persons, for the Executive's**
10 **Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds, in the amount of
13 \$30,617.85, from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") are available
14 to the County of Summit to complete minor home repairs for income-qualified persons outside
15 the cities of Akron, Barberton and Cuyahoga Falls; and

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17 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic
18 Development has a minor home repair program for income-qualified persons; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the appropriation of the aforementioned CDBG funds is necessary and in the best interest of
22 the County of Summit;

45 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
46 provide for the necessary CDBG funds appropriations for the County Executive's Department of
47 Community and Economic Development.

7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
