7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a five-year agreement with**  
8 **Portage County Combined General Health District for backup plumbing inspection**  
9 **services, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/19, to be provided upon request by either**  
10 **county, in the amount of \$71.53 per hour plus mileage and business expenses, for the**  
11 **Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development – Building Standards**  
12 **Division, and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, both Summit County and Portage County are charged with the enforcement  
15 of plumbing rules and regulations and have employed certified plumbing inspectors; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, both counties need part-time occasional certified plumbing inspectors to  
18 supplement full-time certified employees by reason of their employees being on sick leave or  
19 vacation; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, it is most cost effective for each county to use neighboring agencies'  
22 personnel for backup plumbing inspection services; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, Summit County and Portage County Combined General Health District  
25 have agreed to execute a five-year agreement for backup plumbing inspection services, for the  
26 period 1/1/15 through 12/31/19, to be provided upon request by either county, in the amount of  
27 \$71.53 per hour plus mileage and business expenses; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
30 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County  
31 Executive to execute a five-year agreement with Portage County Combined General Health  
32 District for backup plumbing inspection services, for the period 1/1/15 through 12/31/19, to be  
33 provided upon request by either county, in the amount of \$71.53 per hour plus mileage and  
34 business expenses;

36 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the County of  
37 Summit, State of Ohio, that:

39 SECTION 1

41 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a five-year agreement with Portage  
42 County Combined General Health District for backup plumbing inspection services, for the  
43 period 1/1/15 through 12/31/19, to be provided upon request by either county, in the amount of  
44 \$71.53 per hour plus mileage and business expenses. A copy of the agreement is attached hereto  
45 as Exhibit A.

49 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
50 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is immediately  
51 necessary to authorize the Executive to execute the backup plumbing inspection services  
52 agreement with Portage County effective 1/1/15.
