7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the awards of federal funds from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a**
9 **Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Victims of Crime Act grant in the amount of \$31,433.50, with a**
10 **local cash match requirement of \$7,858.50, with an additional supplement of \$25,708.00 in**
11 **Title IV-E funds, for a total of \$65,000.00, and a State Victims Assistance Act grant in the**
12 **amount of \$3,286.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the period 10/1/14 through**
13 **9/30/15, and appropriating \$68,286.00 for expenditures through 12/31/14, for the County of**
14 **Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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16 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division has
17 received an award from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a Federal Fiscal Year
18 2015 Victims of Crime Act (“VOCA”) grant in the amount of \$31,433.50, with a 25% local cash
19 match requirement of \$7,858.50, and supplemental funds from Title IV-E for a VOCA award
20 total of \$65,000.00, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division has received an award from
23 the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office of a Federal Fiscal Year 2015 State Victims
24 Assistance Act (“SVAA”) grant in the amount of \$3,286.00, with no local cash match
25 requirement, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, and for which the Ohio Attorney General’s
26 Office requires an accounting identity separate from the VOCA award; and

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28 WHEREAS, the VOCA and SVAA are annual grants which help to support salary and
29 benefits for a victim advocate and a victim services coordinator, both full-time staff providing
30 advocacy services to crime victims in Summit County; and

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32 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas – Juvenile Division provides
33 for the required VOCA grant match within its annual budget; and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
37 execute any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grants from the
38 State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office, and to appropriate these grant funds;

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40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
41 of Ohio, that:

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45 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
46 the awards of a Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Victims of Crime Act (“VOCA”) grant in the amount
47 of \$31,433.50, with a local cash match requirement of \$7,858.50, with an additional supplement
48 of \$25,708.00 in Title IV-E funds, and a State Victims Assistance Act (“SVAA”) grant in the
49 amount of \$3,286.00, from the State of Ohio Attorney General’s Office, for the period 10/1/14
50 through 9/30/15.

10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


