7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements and any other**
8 **necessary documents pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code for**
9 **inter-county transfers of surplus funds between the Executive's Department of Job and**
10 **Family services and the Geauga, Wayne and Portage County Departments of Job and**
11 **Family Services, pursuant to which agreements Summit County will transfer \$63,000.00 in**
12 **surplus Food Assistance Employment and Training Participation funds to Geauga County,**
13 **accept \$100,000.00 in surplus Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Administration**
14 **funds from Geauga County and appropriate the difference, in the amount of \$37,000.00,**
15 **will accept \$30,000.00 in surplus Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Summer Youth**
16 **funds from Wayne County and will accept \$100,000.00 in surplus Temporary Assistance**
17 **for Needy Families Summer Youth funds from Portage County and appropriate said funds,**
18 **in a total amount of \$130,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family**
19 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

21 WHEREAS, Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code authorizes counties to
22 execute a JFS 02719 "Inter-county Agreement and Certification and Release and Acceptance of
23 Funds" to engage in inter-county transfers of surplus funds allocated to county departments of
24 job and family services by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; and

26 WHEREAS, Summit County and Geauga County wish to enter into an agreement
27 pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which Summit County will transfer \$63,000.00 in
28 surplus Food Assistance Employment and Training Participation funds to Geauga County, accept
29 \$100,000.00 in surplus Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Administration funds from
30 Geauga County and appropriate the difference, in the amount of \$37,000.00; and

32 WHEREAS, Summit County and Wayne County wish to enter into an agreement
33 pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which Summit County will accept \$30,000.00 in
34 surplus Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Summer Youth funds from Wayne County;
35 and

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37 WHEREAS, Summit County and Portage County wish to enter into an agreement
38 pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 pursuant to which Summit County will accept \$100,000.00 in
39 surplus Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Summer Youth funds from Portage County;
40 and

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42 WHEREAS, Summit County will appropriate said funds received from Wayne and
43 Portage Counties, in a total amount of \$130,000.00; and

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45 WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the County Executive to execute the
46 aforementioned agreements with Geauga, Wayne and Portage Counties and any other necessary
47 documents pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 to implement said inter-county transfers and
48 acceptances of surplus funds between the counties' respective departments of job and family
49 services; and

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51 WHEREAS, it is further necessary to appropriate said surplus funds received by the
52 County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("SCDJFS") as stated above; and

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4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
5 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
6 execute the aforementioned agreements with Geauga, Wayne and Portage Counties and any
7 other necessary documents pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 to implement said inter-county
8 transfers and acceptances of surplus funds between the counties' respective departments of job
9 and family services and to appropriate said surplus funds received by SDJFS;

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11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
12 of Ohio, that:

14 SECTION 1

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16 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute agreements and any other
17 necessary documents pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code for inter-
18 county transfers of surplus funds between the Executive's Department of Job and Family
19 services ("SCDFS") and the Geauga, Wayne and Portage County departments of job and family
20 services, pursuant to which agreements Summit County will transfer \$63,000.00 in surplus Food
21 Assistance Employment and Training Participation funds to Geauga County, accept \$100,000.00
22 in surplus Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Administration funds from Geauga County
23 and appropriate the difference, in the amount of \$37,000.00, will accept \$30,000.00 in surplus
24 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Summer Youth funds from Wayne County and will
25 accept \$100,000.00 in surplus Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Summer Youth funds
26 from Portage County and appropriate said funds, in a total amount of \$130,000.00.

44 any other necessary documents pursuant to Section 5101:9-6-82 to implement inter-county
45 transfers and acceptances of surplus funds between the counties' respective departments of job
46 and family services and to immediately appropriate said surplus funds received by SDJFS.
