A Resolution authorizing the Executive, Prosecutor and Clerk of Courts to establish an hourly rate of pay for 8 classified, non-bargaining, employees of \$15.00, for Council and the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, there are presently 8 full time classified non-bargaining employees within the Charter Offices of Executive, Prosecutor and Clerk of Courts who earn less than \$15.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit require this Council's approval to set this hourly rate for these 8 employees; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Human Resources will review the personnel action for the aforementioned changes as required by Section 169.07(b) of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the changes will be submitted to the Director of the Department of Finance and Budget for certification of availability of appropriated funds, as required by Section 169.07(b) of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that establishing an hourly rate of pay for 8 classified, non-bargaining, employees of \$15.00, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

This Council hereby determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to immediately authorize the Executive, Prosecutor and Clerk of Courts to establish an hourly rate of pay of \$15.00 for 8 classified, non-bargaining, employees who currently earn less than that amount.

## SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately properly compensate various employees of the County.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
