7 **An Ordinance amending Section 1307.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit entitled “Accessory Structure Permit Fees,” to Exempt Nonprofit Corporations,**  
9 **Organized under Section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code and other**  
10 **governmental entities, subject to the discretion of the Law Director, from the Payment of**  
11 **Permit Fees for Tents, for the Executive’s Department of Law and Risk Management and**  
12 **declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, Chapter 1307 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
15 (“Codified Ordinances”), entitled “Fees,” sets forth the permit fees for the Department of  
16 Building Standards under Part Thirteen - Building Code; and

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18 WHEREAS, Section 1307.08 of the Codified Ordinances, entitled “Accessory Structure  
19 Permit Fees,” sets forth the permit fee for tents; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, the County shall amend Section 1307.08 of the Codified Ordinances,  
22 entitled “Accessory Structure Permit Fees,” to exempt nonprofit corporations, organized under  
23 Section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code and other governmental entities, subject  
24 to the discretion of the Law Director, from the payment of permit fees for tents; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Section 1307.08 of  
28 the Codified Ordinances, entitled “Accessory Structure Permit Fees,” for the reason set forth  
29 above.

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
32 State of Ohio, that:

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34 SECTION 1

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36 Section 1307.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled  
37 “Accessory Structure Permit Fees,” is amended to exempt nonprofit corporations, organized  
38 under Section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code and other governmental entities,  
39 subject to the discretion of the Law Director, from the payment of permit fees for tents, as set  
40 forth in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

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42 SECTION 2

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44 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
45 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately  
46 amending Section 1307.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled  
47 “Accessory Structure Permit Fees,” to exempt nonprofit corporations, organized under Section  
48 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code and other governmental entities, subject to the  
49 discretion of the Law Director, from the payment of permit fees for tents.

7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


