7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Greenleaf Family Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide assessments**
9 **to identify individuals who may require enhanced Court services through the Summit**
10 **County Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison program, from 7/1/21 through 6/30/23,**
11 **in an amount not to exceed \$307,600.00, for the Executive's Department of Law and Risk**
12 **Management – Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Summit County Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison Plan (the
15 "Plan") was developed to assist in maintaining most felony offenders locally, as well as
16 providing additional programming and supervision for other low level offenders who may be
17 displaced by a felony offender who is sentenced to the Jail; and

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19 WHEREAS, a part of the Plan is to provide assessments for the Common Pleas Court to
20 help with early identification of individuals who may require enhanced services through a
21 specialized docket which would expedite programs and services for these individuals in lieu of
22 incarceration; and

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24 WHEREAS, the Greenleaf Family Center has provided assessment services for the Court
25 of Common Pleas for the Plan since 2017 as well as providing similar assessment services for
26 various Summit County agencies and Courts since 2009; and

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28 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a professional service contract with the
29 Greenleaf Family Center to provide said programs and services to individuals pursuant to the
30 Plan; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 19, 2021, awarded a
33 professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center, as a Best Practical Source, to
34 provide assessments to identify individuals who may require enhanced Court services through
35 the Summit County Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison program, from 7/1/21 through
36 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$307,600.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
39 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center is necessary
40 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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42 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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47 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Greenleaf
48 Family Center, as a Best Practical Source, to provide assessments to identify individuals who
49 may require enhanced Court services through the Summit County Targeted Community
50 Alternatives to Prison program, from 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed
51 \$307,600.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
52 professional service contract and any necessary related documents.
