A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Summit County Court Technology Project at the Summit County Courthouse, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for an amount not to exceed \$298,800.00, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services—Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-196, which confirmed a professional service contract with MCM Consulting Group, Inc. for consulting and project management services for jail management and virtual courtroom systems, due to the public health emergency with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic and as part of MCM's analysis it was recommended that the County utilize broadband technology to connect courts, public safety and social services agencies in a closed network to ensure the secure and efficient continuation of criminal justice operations while ensuring that defendants' and inmates' constitutional rights are fully protected and maintaining the necessary safety protocols due to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-257, which authorized the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the City of Fairlawn for \$6,500,000.00 for the design and construction of a fiber-optic network to connect the Summit County Jail, various courthouses, policing agencies and social services providers as a part of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-297, which authorized the Executive to execute a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad for the Summit County Jail Video Arraignment Project at the Jail in an amount not to exceed \$202,820.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-358, which authorized the Executive to execute a professional service contract with ExhibitOne Corp. for hardware and software to support county-wide virtual courtroom proceedings and related services in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00; and

WHEERAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-116, which authorized the Executive to advertise for bids for the Summit County Court Technology Upgrade Project, in an amount not to exceed \$343,000.00, to complete the Courthouse portion of the project by wiring all 15 courtrooms for technology that will allow video arraignments and other hearings without requiring Sheriff's Office staff transferring inmates to the Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its June 2, 2021 meeting, awarded a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$298,800.00, subject to confirmation by this Council;

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Summit County Court Technology Project at the Summit County Courthouse, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for an amount not to exceed \$298,800.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes a necessary construction contract to complete the Courthouse portion of the project by wiring all 15 courtrooms for technology that will allow video arraignments and other hearings without requiring Sheriff's Office staff transferring inmates to the Courthouse.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
