A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, the Ohio Department of Medicaid and the Summit County Children Services Board for grants received by Summit County Children Services during State Fiscal Years 2022 and 2023, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, for Summit County Children Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code provides, commencing 7/1/08, that the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS") may only make grants to counties through subgrant agreements described in that section; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, ODJFS developed a standard subgrant agreement to be executed by the commissioners, or in the case of a charter county, the executive, of each county prior to receiving ODJFS grant funds; and

WHEREAS, effective 7/1/17, the State determined it was necessary to add the Ohio Department of Medicaid ("ODM") to the subgrant agreement due to the County's receipt of funds from that agency; and

WHEREAS, Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") has received from the State the standard subgrant agreement for State Fiscal Years ("SFY") 2022 and 2023, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, that sets forth the rights and responsibilities of ODJFS, ODM and SCCS in relation to any grant that is awarded for SFY 2022 and 2023; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute said subgrant agreement with ODJFS, ODM and the SCCS Board for SFY 2022 and 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The Executive is authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS") and Ohio Department of Medicaid ("ODM") and the Summit County Children Services Board for grants received by Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") for State Fiscal Years ("SFY") 2022 and 2023, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23. The Executive is hereby authorized to execute said subgrant agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said subgrant agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately authorize the Executive to execute said subgrant agreement so that SCCS is eligible to be awarded grant funds from ODJFS and ODM for SFY 2022 and 2023 effective 7/1/21.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
