A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with T-Mobile, to provide wireless hotspot internet connectivity services, from 6/1/21 through 12/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$383,985.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Jobs and Family Services ("DJFS") seeks to enter into a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") agreement with T-Mobile to provide wireless hotspot internet connectivity services; and

WHEREAS, hotspot hardware and services will be provided for TANF eligible residents in order to lessen the "digital divide" experienced by low income persons in accessing job readiness, job search and educational opportunities.
