DESCRIPTION NO

A Resolution authorizing the Executive, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to execute a renewal (second and final) of professional service contracts authorizing the Executive to disburse funds, including those that exceed an aggregate of \$50,000.00, to all Non-Emergency Medical Transportation providers operating under contract with the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services in Federal Fiscal Year 2022, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an estimated total amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-343, which authorized the Executive to advertise for bids for Non-Emergency Medical Transportation ("NET") providers to transport Medicaid eligible Summit County residents to medical appointments, both in and out of the County, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the bid specifications provided for an initial nine-month term for contracts with NET providers, from 1/1/20 through 9/30/20, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, from 10/1/20 through 9/30/21 and from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22; and

WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Service ("DJFS") coordinates and monitors NET services for eligible Summit County Medicaid clients through NET providers via portal-to-portal-to-portal transportation, which is funded by federal pass-through Medicaid dollars; and

WHEREAS, NET provides state mandated transportation services for Medicaid eligible Summit County residents to medical appointments, both in and out of the county, for critical services, such as, renal dialysis and chemotherapy; and

WHEREAS, DJFS is responsible for providing the payment of invoices received from NET providers who have provided NET services to Summit County residents whom DJFS has deemed eligible for Medicaid services, with said payments being funded by federal pass-through Medicaid dollars; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-469, which authorized the Executive to disburse pass-through funds, including those that exceed an aggregate of \$50,000.00, to NET providers under the aforementioned program in Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2020, for the period 1/1/20 through 9/30/20; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-252, which authorized the Executive to disburse pass-through funds, including those that exceed an aggregate of \$50,000.00, to NET providers under the aforementioned program in Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2021, for the period 10/1/20 through 9/30/21; and

WHEREAS, in Calendar Year 2020, DJFS paid the following vendors for services provided under these agreements; and:

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WHEREAS, it may be necessary to exceed an aggregate of \$50,000.00 in disbursements of the pass-through funds to the providers under the above-referenced program in FFY 2022, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/22; and

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WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to disburse pass-through funds, including those that exceed an aggregate of \$50,000.00, to NET providers under the aforementioned program in FFY 2022, for the period 1/1/21 through 9/30/22;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

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SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to execute a renewal (second and final) of professional service contracts authorizing the Executive to disburse funds, including those that exceed an aggregate of \$50,000.00, to all Non-Emergency Medical Transportation ("NET") providers operating under contract with the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") to provide payment for invoices received from said providers for transportation services to residents whom DJFS has deemed eligible for Medicaid services in Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2022, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an estimated total amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing the Executive to disburse the pass-through funds, including those exceeding \$50,000.00, to NET providers in FFY 2022, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/22.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
