WHEREAS, to enhance the security of its network, the County wishes to enter into an agreement with CDW-G, LLC., for installation of the Thales SafeNet Trusted Access multifactor authentication product, licenses for its use, and maintenance for three years for the Office of Information Technology, in an amount not to exceed \$149,586.00; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Information Technology Board, at its meeting on September 9, 2021, authorized the County Executive to enter into an agreement with CDW-G, LLC., for installation of the Thales SafeNet Trusted Access multifactor authentication product and licenses and maintenance for three years for the Office of Information Technology, in an amount not to exceed \$149,586.00;

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 15, 2021, awarded an agreement with CDW-G, LLC for installation of the Thales SafeNet Trusted Access multifactor authentication product, purchase of licenses for its use, and maintenance for three years for the Office of Information Technology, in an amount not to exceed \$149,586.00subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned contract with CDW-G, LLC is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
