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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Farrwest Environmental Supply, Inc. for a rugged, handheld system 2 integrating Fourier-**
9 **transform infrared spectroscopy for the Columbiana County HazMat Team, in an amount**
10 **not to exceed \$64,950.00, for the Executive's Department of Public Safety, Emergency**
11 **Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-239, which authorized
14 the Executive to advertise for bids for multiple pieces of equipment for various Hazardous
15 Response and Special Operations Teams, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$355,000.00;

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18 WHEREAS, among the pieces of equipment for which the Executive was authorized to
19 advertise for bids was a rugged, handheld system 2 integrating Fourier-transform infrared
20 spectroscopy for the Columbiana County HazMat Team, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
21 \$70,000.00; and

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23 WHEREAS, the Executive advertised for bids from October 9, 2021, through October 25,
24 2021, and received three bids; and

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26 WHEREAS, after reviewing the bids, the Executive has selected Farrwest Environmental
27 Supply, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 17, 2021, awarded a
30 purchase contract with Farrwest Environmental Supply, Inc. for a rugged, handheld system 2
31 integrating Fourier-transform infrared spectroscopy, for the Columbiana County HazMat Team,
32 in an amount not to exceed \$64,950.00; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
35 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Farrwest Environmental Supply, Inc. is necessary
36 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


