A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement

between Ohio Council 8 and Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (JFS Unit), and the Executive for the period 1/1/24 through 12/31/26, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and

declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between Ohio Council 8 and Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (JFS Unit), and the Executive, for the period 1/1/24 through 12/31/26, with an increase in pay of three and one-half percent (3.5%) in the first year of the agreement (1/1/2024), three percent (3.0%) in the second year of the agreement (1/1/2025), and two and one-half percent (2.5%) in the third year of the agreement (1/1/2026); and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (JFS Unit), and the Executive, for the period 1/1/24 through 12/31/26, an increase in pay of three and one-half percent (3.5%) in the first year of the agreement (1/1/2024), three percent (3.0%) in the second year of the agreement (1/1/2025), and two and one-half percent (2.5%) in the third year of the agreement (1/1/2026).

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing a timely collective bargaining agreement between Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (JFS Unit), and the Executive.

## SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
