1 RESOLUTION NO. 2024-011 2 SPONSOR Executive Shapiro 3 4 DATE January 8, 2024 COMMITTEE Planning 5 6 7 A Resolution to authorize the Executive to submit construction permit applications to the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission and to assume responsibility for the costs 8 and any liabilities arising from such construction on Turnpike property, located in the City 9 of Hudson, Village of Boston Heights, Boston Township, and Richfield Township, in 10 Council Districts 1 and 3, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency. 11 12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution 2022-192, which supported the 13 construction of a fiber optic ring throughout the County (the "Project"); and 14 15 WHEREAS, in furtherance of the construction of the Project, permits to cross property 16 owned by the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission (the "Commission") located in the 17 City of Hudson, Village of Boston Heights, Boston Township, and Richfield Township, in 18 Council Districts 1 and 3, are required; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Commission, as a condition of issuing such permits, requires political 21 subdivisions to assume responsibility for all of the costs of construction, future maintenance of 22 the Project, and all liabilities and costs that may be incurred during the construction and life span 23 of the installation of any improvement crossing and located on Commission property; and 24 25 WHEREAS, through this resolution, the County will assume responsibility for all of the 26 costs of construction, future maintenance of the Project, and all liabilities and costs that may be 27 incurred during the construction and life span of the Project which are constructed on 28 Commission property; and 29 30 31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to 32 submit permit applications and to enter into contracts with the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure 33 Commission as may be necessary to obtain permits to construct portions of the Project on 34 Commission property for the aforementioned reason; 35 36 37 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that: 38 39 **SECTION 1** 40 41 The County of Summit, with respect to work done on Commission property pursuant to 42 permits issued by the Commission to the County, assumes and shall be responsible for all related 43 costs of construction, including inspection, and for future maintenance of the Project, and it shall 44 relieve the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission of all liabilities and costs that may be 45 incurred during and arising out of the construction and life span of the Project. The Executive is 46 hereby authorized on behalf of the County of Summit to submit permit applications and to enter 47 into contracts with the Ohio Turnpike and Infrastructure Commission as may be necessary to 48 obtain permits to construct portions of the Project on Commission property. 49 50 51
