A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with United Labor Agency, to add Benefit Bridge Employer Pilot Program Services, in an amount not to exceed \$617,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 101.82%), for a total amount not to exceed \$1,223,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2023-178, which authorized the Executive to execute a contract with United Labor Agency to provide Benefit Bridge services in an amount not to exceed \$606,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the services provided under said contract assist Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") eligible persons in attaining and maintaining employment while assisting them with potential rapid public assistance benefits reductions known as the "benefits cliff". Recipients increasing income due to obtaining employment often quickly experience a reduction or loss of essential benefits, such as, supplemental nutrition assistance program services ("SNAP"), cash assistance, Medicaid, housing and childcare subsidies. Often benefit losses are not offset by new earnings, making it very difficult to maintain employment; and

WHEREAS, this change order is necessary to add Benefit Bridge Employer Pilot Program Services, which is a two-year pilot program offered by Ohio Department of Job and Family Services that awards grants to Ohio employers to incentivize employees enrolled in public assistance programs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its January 3, 2024 meeting, awarded the above-referenced change order in an amount not to exceed \$617,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 101.82%), for a total amount not to exceed \$1,223,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned contract with United Labor Agency is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
