Johnson) SPONSORS Executive Shapiro & Ms. Sims, Council as a Whole 3 4 5 DATE January 29, 2024 COMMITTEE Human Services 6 7 A Resolution declaring the month of February 2024 as Black History Month in Summit 8 County, recognizing the incredible accomplishments made by Black Americans in the face 9 of adversity, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency. 10 11 WHEREAS, the first Black History Month was proposed and celebrated by the faculty of 12 the Center of Pan-African Culture and members of Black United Students at Kent State University 13 in 1970, conferring local significance on what would become a national observance in 1976; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the Civil Rights Movement prompted historians and educators to expand the 16 teachings of Black history and properly recognize the contributions of Black scientists, artists, educators, athletes, politicians, business people, faith leaders, and countless others in the United 17 18 States and Summit County; and 19 WHEREAS, current movements for racial justice and equity continue to press for the full 20 21 implementation of the tenets and values of the Civil Rights Movement, such as equal treatment under the law, as well as increased awareness of the experiences and identities of people of color; 22 23 and 24 25 WHEREAS, the foundations of the Civil Rights Movement, and subsequently Black 26 History Month, were paved by countless leaders, such as Sojourner Truth, who gave her renowned 27 speech in Akron, Ohio in 1851, declaring movements for justice and equality must fight for the 28 rights of all races and all women, including Black women; and 29 30 WHEREAS, in 2022, the Sojourner Truth Project and key partners broke ground on 31 Sojourner Truth Memorial Plaza, which honors Truth, her speech, and her legacy, which still holds 32 immense value today; and 33 34 WHEREAS, in 2024, Summit County will celebrate the unveiling of Sojourner Truth 35 Memorial Plaza, providing a site of historical, educational, and cultural significance for the 36 community, the state, and the nation; and 37 38 WHEREAS, despite great progress, there continues to be disparities in the United States 39 and Summit County between people of different racial and ethnic backgrounds; and 40 41 WHEREAS, Summit County remains committed to fostering a workplace and community 42 that is diverse, inclusive, and equitable for employees and residents alike through programs and 43 practices set out by strategic planning; and 44 45 WHEREAS, Black History Month provides time to reflect on progress toward justice and 46 equality, as well as barriers to building a better future; and 47 48 WHEREAS, residents are encouraged to participate in events during Black History Month 49 and to take time to explore local history through resources at their local library and the Summit 50 County Historical Society; and 51 52
