7 **A Resolution approving and adopting the Summit County 9-1-1 Plan, for the Executive’s**
8 **Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

10 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 128.06 establishes that every county shall
11 maintain a county 9-1-1 Program Review Committee and that committee shall maintain and
12 approve a plan for implementing and operating the county 9-1-1 system (the “Plan”); and

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14 WHEREAS, the Plan identifies each of the Public Safety Answering Point (“PSAP”) in the
15 County, indicates how they operate, the expense of operation and establishes processes for
16 spending funds that the County receives from the State of Ohio for 9-1-1; and

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18 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 128.08 requires that the final plan shall be
19 adopted by this Council, and shall be adopted by 66 percent of municipalities in Summit County;
20 and

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22 WHEREAS, the Plan was updated in coordination with each PSAP located in Summit
23 County; and

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25 WHEREAS, the updated Plan was subsequently approved by the Summit County 9-1-1
26 Program Review Committee; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve and adopt the
30 aforementioned 9-1-1 Plan;

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32 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
33 of Ohio, that:

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35 SECTION 1

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37 The 2024 Summit County 9-1-1 Plan (the “Plan”), a copy of which is attached hereto as
38 Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, is here by approved and adopted by this Council.

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40 SECTION 2

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42 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
43 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
44 approve and adopt the Plan.

46 SECTION 3

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48 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
49 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and
50 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
9 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
