

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-421

A Resolution pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the Fiscal Officer to hire one person into a temporary part-time non-bargaining classified Computer Programmer position, at a cost of \$30.00/hr. through March 31, 2010, for a total not to exceed cost of \$10,000.00, for the Fiscal Officer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to control and potentially reduce, the County's budget deficit; and

WHEREAS, Section 164(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire a said employee; and

WHEREAS, due to the two Voluntary Separation Plans, the Fiscal Officer has suffered an extreme hardship by a 90% reduction in experienced payroll personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has determined that in order to maintain the effective payroll functions of this department and the County of Summit, and to comply with all federal, state, local laws, the Fiscal Officer requires hiring one person into a temporary part-time non-bargaining classified Computer Programmer position, at a cost of \$30.00/hr. through March 31 2010, for a total not to exceed cost of \$10,000.00;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer requests that this Council adopt a Resolution pursuant to Section 169.04(j) authorizing him hire a person into the aforementioned position; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Fiscal Officer pursuant to Section 169.04(j) to hire one person into a temporary part-time non-bargaining classified Computer Programmer position at a cost of \$30.00/hr. through March 31 2010, for a total not to exceed cost of \$10,000, for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

County Council hereby determines that the Fiscal Officer has demonstrated that it is necessary for the effective and continued operation of the Fiscal Office to authorize the Fiscal Officer, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances, to hire one person into a temporary part-time non-bargaining classified Computer Programmer position, at a cost of \$30.00/hr. through March 31, 2010, for a total not to exceed cost of \$10,000.00.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Fiscal Office to hire a person into a temporary part-time Computer Programmer position.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
