7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into a two-year policing contract**
8 **with Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1, with one option to renew for an additional**
9 **one-year term, for nine Sheriff's Deputies, for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09, and**
10 **seven Sheriff's Deputies for the period 1/1/10 through 12/31/10, in the amount of**
11 **\$854,714.00 for the first year, \$706,879.34 for the second year, and \$746,195.34 for the**
12 **option to renew for a third year, for the period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11, in a total amount**
13 **not to exceed \$1,561,593.34 during the two-year term of the contract, for the Sheriff, and**
14 **declaring an emergency.**

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2005-662, the County Executive executed a
17 three-year policing contract between the County of Summit and Twinsburg Township, in
18 Council District 1, which terminates 12/31/08; and

20 WHEREAS, Twinsburg Township requests that the County enter into a new policing
21 contract to provide nine Sheriff's Deputies for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09 and seven
22 Sheriff's Deputies for the 1/1/10 through 12/31/10 and seven Deputies for the option to renew
23 for an additional one-year term, for the period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11, for seven Sheriff's
24 Deputies; and

26 WHEREAS, Twinsburg Township has agreed to pay the County \$854,714.00 for the first
27 year, \$706,879.34 for the second year and \$746,195.34 for the option to renew for a third year,
28 for a total amount of \$1,561,593.34 during the two-year term of the policing contract; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
31 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
32 the aforementioned policing contract with the Township;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that;

39 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute into a two-year policing contract
40 with Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1, with one option to renew for an additional one-
41 year term, for nine Sheriff's Deputies, for the period 1/1/09 through 12/31/09, and seven
42 Sheriff's Deputies for the period 1/1/10 through 12/31/10, in the amount of \$854,714.00 for the
43 first year, \$706,879.34 for the second year, and \$746,195.34 for the option to renew for a third
44 year, for the period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11, in a total amount not to exceed \$1,561,593.34
45 during the two-year term of the contract.

49 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
50 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
51 providing necessary policing for Twinsburg Township.

8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


