8 **accept the award by the Ohio Emergency Management Agency of a State Fiscal Year 2010**
9 **Statewide Search & Rescue Capability grant, for the period 7/1/09 through 6/30/10, in the**
10 **amount of \$9,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating these funds**
11 **for materials expenditures through 12/31/09, for the Executive's Department of Law,**
12 **Division of Public Safety-Emergency Management, and declaring an emergency**

14 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Public Safety – Emergency Management
15 Agency has awarded State Fiscal Year 2010 Statewide Search & Rescue Capability state funds to
16 the County of Summit Emergency Management Agency, for the period 7/1/09 through 6/30/10,
17 in the amount of \$9,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, to provide materials which
18 will support the State's mission to create a stronger search and rescue capability statewide; and

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20 WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to purchase and upgrade existing equipment and
21 materials necessary for the operation of the Region 5 Type II Collapse Search and Rescue Team
22 and the Structural Collapse Operations course; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
25 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorized the Executive to execute
26 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio
27 Emergency Management Agency, and to appropriate grant funds;

20 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


