7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award by Ohio Department of Public Safety ("ODPS") of a Paul Coverdell**
9 **National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act of 2000 ("Coverdell") funding, for the**
10 **Forensic Pathology Training and Equipment award, for the period 10/1/09 through**
11 **9/30/10, in the amount of \$6,250.46, with no local cash match requirement, and**
12 **appropriating these funds for 2009 expenditures, for the Medical Examiner, and declaring**
13 **an emergency.**

15 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Medical Examiner has received a grant award by
16 ODPS of Coverdell funding for the Forensic Pathology Training and Equipment award, for the
17 period 10/1/09 through 9/30/10, in the amount of \$6,250.46, with no local cash match
18 requirement; and

20 WHEREAS, this funding will provide for two major training sessions for two Summit
21 County forensic pathologists with accreditation credits earned and for the purchase of equipment
22 to maintain two gas chromatographs which will allow the toxicology laboratory to continue to
23 test for drugs and alcohol for police agencies and prosecutors both within Summit and
24 surrounding counties; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
27 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
28 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from ODPS and to
29 appropriate these grant funds;

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
32 of Ohio, that:

36 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
37 the Coverdell Forensic Pathology Training and Equipment award from ODPS for the period
