7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled, "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire**
9 **two external people into full-time non-bargaining unclassified Attorney I positions, at an**
10 **hourly salary of \$20.11/hour each, or, in lieu of the Attorney I position, two part-time non-**
11 **bargaining unclassified Student Helper positions, at an hourly salary of \$10.14/hour, each,**
12 **for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
15 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled, "Temporary
16 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and

17
18 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
19 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
20 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a Resolution authorizing the office to hire
21 said employee; and

23 WHEREAS, due to separations through resignation and retirement, as well as the
24 addition of two new judges for the Court of Common Pleas, General Division, the Prosecutor
25 says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation of her office to be permitted to hire
26 two full-time Attorney I positions, both of which are entry-level positions within the Prosecutor's
27 Office; and

29 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has met its 2010 targeted budget and will make the
30 requested hires within the targeted budget; and

32 WHEREAS, in lieu of hiring either two full-time Attorney I positions, the Prosecutor
33 could hire up to two part-time Student Helper positions, which would enable the Prosecutor to
34 employ current law school students who may be certified to perform prosecutions on behalf of
35 the County; and

37 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Prosecutor to hire either part-time Student Helper
38 positions, if students are available and/or qualified to fill those positions, or the authority to hire
39 two full-time Attorney I positions will be necessary; and

41 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it
42 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor
43 to hire either two external people into full-time non-bargaining unclassified Attorney I positions,
44 at an hourly salary of \$20.11/hour, each, or, in lieu of the Attorney I position, up to two part-time
45 non-bargaining unclassified Student Helper positions, at an hourly salary of \$10.14/hour, each;

47 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,

6 County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is
7 necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize the County
8 Prosecutor, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire up to two external
9 people into full-time non-bargaining unclassified Attorney I positions, at an hourly salary of
10 \$20.11/hour, each, or, in lieu of the Attorney I positions, two part-time non-bargaining
11 unclassified Student Helper positions, at an hourly salary of \$10.14/hour each, within the
12 Prosecutor's 2010 targeted budget.

14 SECTION 2

16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
17 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
18 authorize the County Prosecutor to hire said individuals in order to continue effectively
19 prosecuting cases in Summit County.

21 SECTION 3

23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
25 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
