7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept an award of federal fund by the Ohio Department of Youth Services of a 2009**
9 **Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (“JABG”) for the period 1/01/10 through 12/31/10 in**
10 **the amount of \$46,126.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$7,249.54, and**
11 **appropriating the total of \$53,375.54 for expenditures in 2010, for the Juvenile Court, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Youth Services has awarded a 2009 Juvenile
15 Accountability Block Grant (“JABG”) of federal funds to the Juvenile Court for the period
16 1/01/10 through 12/31/10 in the amount of \$46,126.00, with a local cash match requirement of
17 \$7,249.54 to provide for salaries and benefits of a probation officer; and

18
19 WHEREAS, the JABG funded probation officer will provide probation services to higher
20 at-risk youth in order to reduce delinquency and recidivism among this population; and

22 WHEREAS, the JABG’s local cash match will be provided by the Juvenile Court’s
23 RECLAIM funds; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
26 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
27 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned JABG grant from the Ohio
28 Department of Youth Services, and to appropriate these grant funds;

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that:

35 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
36 the award of a 2009 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant award from the Ohio Department of
37 Youth Services for the period 1/01/10 through 12/31/10, in the amount of \$46,126.00, with a
38 \$7,249.54 local cash match requirement.


