7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**
8 **accept the award by the Ohio Department of Youth Services of a Title II Formula Grant**
9 **for a Juvenile Court Diversion Program for the period 1/01/10 through 12/31/10 in the**
10 **amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating these**
11 **federal funds for expenditures in calendar year 2010, for the Juvenile Court, and declaring**
12 **an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Youth Services has awarded a Title II Formula
15 Grant to the Juvenile Court for the period 1/01/10 through 12/31/10 in the amount of
16 \$103,232.00 with no local match requirement, for a Diversion Program; and

17 WHEREAS, this is the second year funding for this diversion program which is focused
18 on African American and other minorities in the ten (10) through seventeen (17) age range; and

20 WHEREAS, this will provide funding for Juvenile Court case management services and
21 for Greenleaf contracted services for further assessments, planning, counseling, and treatment for
22 this population; and

24 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
25 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute
26 any document necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio
27 Department of Youth Services, and to appropriate these grant funds;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

34 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
35 the Title II Formula Grant award of federal funds from the Ohio Department of Youth Services
36 for the period 1/01/10 through 12/31/10, in the amount of \$103,232.00, with no local cash match

20 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


