18 the County of Summit through the Community Corrections Act has awarded to the County of
19 Summit grant funds for State Fiscal Year 2009 in the amount of \$232,907.00, with no local cash
20 match requirement. to support three current caseworkers, one additional caseworker and one
21 probation officer for an expansion of the County of Summit Court of Common Pleas' Reentry
22 Court, for the period of 7/1/09 through 6/30/10; and

25 aforementioned grant awards; and
