7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for improvement of**
8 **Akron Peninsula Road, located in Boston Township and the Village of Peninsula, in**
9 **Council District 1, at an estimated total cost to the County of Summit not to exceed \$**
10 **510,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, an improvement is proposed for approximately 1.16 miles of Akron
13 Peninsula Road, from approximately 1,000 feet south of Truxell Road (C.H. 187) to Orchard
14 Street (located approximately 500 feet south of State Route 303 in the Village of Peninsula),
15 including pavement and shoulder resurfacing, said road section being located in Boston
16 Township, and the Village of Peninsula; and

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18 WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project is \$ 510,000.00, with \$475,000.00 of
19 said cost to be funded by Public Lands Highway Discretionary funds, and with the remaining
20 \$35,000.00 to be borne by the County of Summit, of which \$35,000.00 is 100% Engineer funds;
21 and

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23 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
24 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids for projects
25 that are included in the Engineer's First Quarter Calendar Year 2010 Capital Improvement
26 Program; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
29 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that the County Executive be
30 authorized to advertise for bids for the Akron Peninsula Road Improvement Project;

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32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
33 of Ohio, that;

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35 SECTION 1

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37 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the improvement of Akron
38 Peninsula Road, located in Boston Township and the Village of Peninsula, in Council District 1,
39 at a total estimated cost to the County of Summit not to exceed of \$ 510,000.00.

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41 SECTION 2

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43 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest if the health, safety, and welfare
44 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately expedites
45 roadway improvements that will increase the safety and ease of highway use.
