7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, entitled "Temporary Hiring Freeze," to authorize the County Prosecutor to hire a**
9 **total of three external people into full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified, Attorney I**
10 **positions, two positions in the criminal division, and one position in the tax division, for the**
11 **Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2009-110, which enacted
14 Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Temporary
15 Hiring Freeze," to control and reduce the County's budget deficit; and
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17 WHEREAS, Section 169.04(j) provides that if a County office is able to demonstrate that
18 the filling of an existing position by hiring an employee is necessary for the effective and
19 continued operation of the office, Council may adopt a resolution authorizing the office to hire
20 said employees; and
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22 WHEREAS, due to separations through two resignation and one retirement, the
23 Prosecutor says it is necessary for the continued and effective operation of her office to be
24 permitted to hire and fill three full-time Attorney I positions, which are entry-level positions
25 within the Prosecutor's Office; and
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27 WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it
28 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Prosecutor
29 to hire three external people into full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified Attorney I positions;
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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
32 State of Ohio, that:

34 SECTION 1
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36 County Council hereby determines that the County Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is
37 necessary for the effective and continued operation of her office to authorize the County
38 Prosecutor, pursuant to Section 169.04(j) of the Codified Ordinance, to hire up to three external
39 people into full-time, non-bargaining, unclassified Attorney I positions.
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41 SECTION 2
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43 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
44 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
45 authorize the County Prosecutor to hire said individuals in order to continue effectively
46 prosecuting cases and collect revenue for Summit County.
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48 SECTION 3
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50 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
51 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise it shall take effect
52 and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
